

Private Sites

No spectators allowed to attend. 1 parent/guardian for players under 18.

What is a private site?

The land is privately owned by the club or another owner

The public do not have free access to the site

The site is only accessible via a gated or single access point, with no thoroughfare

Club Responsibility

Discourage members from attending fixtures and training at private sites. Other than the 1 parent/guardian.

If spectators associated with your Club attend private venues- ask them to leave.

Send opposition site information prior to fixtures
